Remember, anything that is the same in both goes in the middle of the Venn Diagram. List all non-alike parts for the Fourteen Points on the LEFT side of the Venn and all non-alike parts for the Treaty of Versailles on the RIGHT side of the Venn.

Wilson's Fourteen Points:

- ___ a. All alliances need to be made open and public
- ___ b. All non-Russians leave Russia and let Russia become who it want to be
- ___ c. Austria-Hungary chooses how to reform itself
- ___ d. Belgium is restored and chooses its own government
- ___ e. Colonies should be able to decide for themselves what happens to them
- ___ f. Create Poland and give them freedom to choose what they want to be and freedom of seas
- ___ g. Creates the League of Nations
- ___ h. France should get all of its territory back including Alsace-Lorraine
- ___ i. Free and open seas
- ___ j. Free trade among the nations
- ___ k. Italy is restored and the boundaries include all Italian-speaking areas
- ___ l. Reduce all militaries to just what is needed to keep themselves safe
- ___ m. Romania, Serbia, and Montenegro should be able to be free and set up themselves
- ___ n. Turkey is its own country; the other part of the Ottoman Empire can decide what to do with themselves

The Treaty of Versailles:

1. Reparations for Germany equals \$30 Billion
2. Demilitarization of Germany
 - a. Keep 100,000 men and 6 battleships
 - b. No submarines, tanks, poison gas, aircrafts, airships, and heavy artillery
3. German gives Alsace-Lorraine to France
4. Germany accept a war guilt clause
5. Germany loses all colonies
6. Ban Germany and Austria from uniting (Anschluss)
7. Demilitarize the Rhineland
8. Trials for Kaiser and other German war leaders
9. Create:
